The Boone Soccer Club is happy to announce the Spring 2020 registration! Starting on January 6, 2020 and going until February 14, 2020 at 11:59PM, you are invited to visit the Boone Soccer Club website and click on the link to register. Our website is www.booneiowasoccer.com.



The Boone Soccer Club offers U4, U6, U8, U10, and U12/U14 age divisions in our local Recreational league. Pursuant to the US Youth Soccer rules, players are placed in divisions based upon their birth year. Cost for each age divisions is:

➤ U4	\$40	4 games
➤ U6	\$45	5 games
➤ U8	\$50	6 games
➤ U10	\$55	8 games
➤ U12/U14	\$55	8 games

All Recreational league games are played out at the Boone County Fairgrounds and DMACC. U4, U6 and U8 divisions typically play on Tuesday nights while U10 and U12/U14 teams typically play on Thursday nights. U8, U10 and U12/U14 teams will also have a few games played on the weekend.

The Boone Soccer Club also offer a Select league where teams (U10 & above) play other teams from other towns/cities. The competition is tough and expectations are higher for the athletes. Team availability varies, and we cannot guarantee we will have enough players so if there are not enough for a Select team then they will be able to play in the recreational league. Again, players are placed in divisions based upon their birth year. The cost is \$100 plus jerseys unless they have already played on a Boone Select team and have a jersey. The teams play 7 games, and they are all on Saturday or Sunday depending on the Iowa Soccer Association that makes up the game schedule.

Recreational and Select games start in April except for the U4 and U6 teams which start in May. That means practices will be starting in March or April! The Boone Soccer Club is always in need of parent volunteers to be coaches and assistant coaches. Please consider coaching your son/daughter, your nephew/niece, or even your neighbor. You don't need to know a lot about soccer in the local Recreational league. The Boone Soccer Club has resources to help you deal with practices and games. We can't exist without parents and volunteers so please think about helping out as a coach. Thanks!
